| Cost of living | About 900 € – 1,150 € per month, including housing, meals, health insurance and personal expenses. Students may have to acquire study materials at their own cost. |
| Housing | Student dormitories: The Student Union offers accommodation for students at a reasonable price (about 300 €/month). A number of rooms is available for exchange students. Students note in their online application if they decide to stay in student housing (strongly recommended). The rental period in the dormitory is always a complete semester (6 months) from 1 September – 28 February (winter semester) or from 1 March – 31 August (summer semester). www.th-rosenheim.de/housing |
