Language of Instruction	<p>Programmes at Lotja are delivered through Catalan / Spanish. Exchange applicants should demonstrate an intermediate level of Spanish or Catalan language ability equivalent to B1 on the Common European Framework of References for Languages (CEF). Higher level (B2) might be requested for more technical / theoretical studies.</p> <p>It is compulsory for all incoming students to attend the Spanish classes offered by Lotja throughout the year.</p>
