The application is done through Mobility Online : the International office will send you a link by e-mail to access the platform.

**Autumn semester**  
June 1st

**Spring semester**

## Application form

The student is requested to provide the followings documents :

- Resume and cover letter expressing your motivation to study at ENSSAT
- Most recent transcript of records (copy)
- Diplomas (copy)
- ID / passport (copy)
- Health insurance card (copy)
- Certificate corresponding to the English level required for courses in English (B2 level) or French (B1 level)

# ACADEMIC INFORMATION



## Language of instruction

### French & English

- French level required for courses in French : B2
- English level required for courses in English : B2

## Grading system

Grades range from 0.0 (Failure) to 20.0 (Very Good)

## Transcripts of records

A transcript of records will be sent to the partner university's exchange coordinator at the end of the study period.

## Credits system

ECTS (European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System). One semester is worth 30 ECTS.

## French courses

Students will be given free French classes during their semester at Enssat

## Health insurance

## Deadline to apply for accommodation

### Autumn semester

June 1st

### Spring semester

November 15th

**ENSSAT** is located in the town center, as we do not have a specific campus. Assistance is provided by the international office to find a lodging.

There is also a residence close to ENSSAT offering accommodation :

The monthly rent is around 400/450 €.

It is recommended that students bring at least 700 € cash for the expenses of the first month. Students can open a bank account free. It is necessary for paying rent, health insurance fees & regular debits.
